

COURSE PLANNING FORM, MASTER OF PHYSIOTHERAPY (GENERAL)

1. Master of Physiotherapy by Coursework

The Master of Physiotherapy is comprised of eight (8) subjects, which may either be taken full time for one year, or part time over 2 years (or more). It is comprised of three core subjects, four stream subjects and one elective subject. The core subjects are Graduate Research Methods; Academic Writing, Ethics and Critical Enquiry; Motor Control, Performance and Exercise; Pain and Its Management.

All students take the core subjects Graduate Research Methods and Academic Writing, Ethics and Critical Enquiry, and then select **one of either** Motor Control, Performance and Exercise, **or** Pain and Its Management.

2. Select Four Stream Subjects

Advise them that you are a Master of Physiotherapy (General) student interested in taking their subject, check with them any questions / suitability / issues you need to clarify.
